Shanghai

Host Country

As a country in East Asia, **the People's Republic of China** (abbreviated as **China**) is located on the west coast of the Pacific Ocean. Its land space is 9.6 million square kilometers and maritime area is 4.7 million square kilometers. The length of China's eastern and southern continental coastlines surpasses 18,000 kilometers. Its capital is Beijing.

There are 56 ethnic groups in China, making it a multi-ethnic, multi-lingual, multidialect and multi-text country. The national lingua franca is Putonghua and the standard Chinese characters.

The Chinese nation has a long history. In history, China has always been one of the world's most populous countries, accounting for about 20% of the world's population for a long time. China currently has a population of about 1.41 billion.

China boasts of a vast territory and wide latitude. The distance from the sea is different, coupled with various terrains, forming a variety of climates in China. Speaking of temperature zones, there are tropical, subtropical, warm temperate, medium temperate and cold temperate zone and Qinghai-Tibet Plateau region.

Host City

Shanghai is located in the Yangtze River Delta, covering an area of 6,340.5 square kilometers, and is divided into 16 districts. It is China's largest economic center and a major international financial center with a permanent population of 24.8745 million. "Under the parasol tree stand the old Western-style houses, with stone-framed gates in old alleyways, and the foreign buildings along the Bund." Shanghai intertwines the classical and elegant elements of Wu and Yue culture with the modern and fashionable atmosphere of an international metropolis, forging an incomparable style. It is a well-known international cultural metropolis and a favored destination for international travelers. Within the city, there exists 20 municipal and district-level public libraries, as well as 159 museums and 96 art galleries. Further, the city boasts 68 regular institutions of higher education with 548,700 students and 19 private institutions of higher education with 128,900 students.



Host District

Songjiang District is located in the southwest of Shanghai in the Yangtze Delta area, and along the upper and middle reaches of the Huangpu River. Songjiang has become an increasingly important gateway to Shanghai in the southwest. With a pleasant northern subtropical monsoon climate, Songjiang enjoys four distinct seasons. In June, the average monthly temperature was 24-26 degrees Celsius.





Songjiang District had 11 towns, 6 sub-districts, 293 neighborhood committees, and 84 village committees at the end of 2022. At the end of 2022, the number of permanent residents in the district reached 1.9545 million. In Songjiang, there are National-level Shanghai Songjiang Economic and Technological Development Zone, National-level Shanghai Songjiang Comprehensive Bonded Zone, Sheshan National Tourist Resort, and Songjiang University Town.



Host University

Shanghai University of Engineering Science (SUES) integrates and coordinates engineering, economics, management, art, design, and other disciplines, as one of the higher education institutions. SUES is one of the first batches of pilot universities under the Outstanding Engineer Education and Training Program of the Ministry of Education, the pioneer of Emerging Engineering Education and High-level Application-oriented Universities in Shanghai. Since 2017, SUES has been applying to be a doctoral degree-awarding institution in Shanghai.

Adhering to the concept of globalized education, SUES actively introduces quality international educational resources to improve its internal construction and student training. Currently, SUES have established partnerships with over 110 universities or institutions from more than 20 countries and regions, including the United States, Canada, Britain, Mexico, the UK, Germany, France, Italy, Sweden, Switzerland, South Korea, Japan, Singapore, Malaysia, Kazakhstan, and Pakistan.








Cultural Experience Activity Site

Guangfulin Cultural Relics Park is listed as the seventh batch of national key cultural relics protection units in the People's Republic of China. The park includes Guangfulin Underwater Cultural Exhibition Hall, Ancient Pottery Art Museum, Guandi Temple, Chenghuang Temple, and Guangfulin Archaeological Site Exhibition Hall. It is known as the root of Shanghai's historical and cultural heritage and the origin of the "Haipai" culture.

In addition to visiting the park, OC will also arrange more than 30 traditional Chinese cultural programs for participants to experience.

Participation countries are as follows:

Competition System and Regulations

General Teams

The Futsal tournaments shall be organized in accordance with FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game authorized by the Sub-Committee or IFAB. If any dispute, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the OC and the CTI. The competitions shall last eight days and include:

- one men's tournament

- one women's tournament

The tournaments shall take place indoors.

Each country/region is authorized to enter a maximum of 19 persons: a maximum of 14 and a minimum of 10 players and 5 officials per tournament.

Each country may enter:

- one men's team of 14 players (5 effectives and 9 substitutes)

- one women's team of 14 players (5 effectives and 9 substitutes)

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.





• Competition Format, Classification

The system of play used will be the league system, each team playing one match against each of the other teams in the same group, with three points for a win, one point for a draw, and none for a defeat.

The ranking of each team in each group will be determined as follows:

a) Higher number of points obtained in all group matches;

b) Goal difference in all group matches;

c) Higher number of goals scored in all group matches.

If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above three criteria, their rankings will be determined as follows:

d) Higher number of points obtained in the group matches between the teams concerned;

e) Goal difference resulting from the group matches between the teams concerned;

f) Higher number of goals scored in all group matches between the teams concerned;

g) Drawing of lots by the local OC, in the presence of the team captains.

Depending on the format and number of teams, the top ranked ones in each group will advance to the knockout stage. The rest of the teams will play the lower ranking.

• Participation

> Only the following may take part in the Championships:

a) An association with membership of FISU;

b) In the case of non-affiliation to FISU:

- A country/region whose Olympic Committee is allowed to take part in the Olympic Games;

- A country/region not having an Olympic Committee recognised by the IOC may take part in those sports for which there is a NF of that country/region which is affiliated to the appropriate IF. The FISU Executive Committee will take a decision for each sport in which the country/region wishes to participate.

Only the athletes who comply with the following conditions may take part in a FISU
World University Championship:

a) Be a national of the country/region they represent;

b) Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event; for 2024, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1999 and the 31/12/2006.

Fees

FISU registration fees

- FISU shall receive from each competing country or region the following FISU registration fees:





a) Effective member associations of FISU: 20 EUR per athlete and official "with all membership fees payment in order";

b) Other associations: 40 EUR per athlete and official;

- FISU registration fees will be charged to the NUSF at the end of the Championships season. An invoice per event will be created. Each Head of delegation must sign the invoice related to the participation at the event. By signing this invoice, the Head of Delegation confirm the number of participants of the concerned delegation and acknowledge the receipt of this invoice.

Travel costs

- The country or region shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to the nearest official point of entry (approved by FISU) of the Championship and return.

- The designated airport or other entry point must be approved by the FISU WUC Department.

Participation Fee

Generally, all delegations, who submit the Quantitative Entry agree to attend the event and pay the participation fee. The participation fee is 80 EUR per day per person. The fee includes full board (including drinking water), accommodation, transportation from/to official airports/train station, transportation from/to competition venue, hotels, ceremonies

The fees are invoiced based on the following conditions:

- The departure day (July 17th) will not be charged because on this day OC only provides breakfast and transport to the Main Station or Airport. But the delegation needs to complete the check-out procedures before 12:00 noon.

- A maximum of 10 days can be charged to the delegation (Friday, 7th to Monday, 17th)

- A minimum of 9 days will be charged to the NUSF (Saturday, 8th to Monday, 17th)

- The final payment will be calculated for 9 or 10 days, depending on your arrival day.

- If there are more than 19 participants, participation fee is 140 EUR per person and per night for Extra officials.

Country or region entering in team sports must pay to FISU a deposit per team defined in the technical regulations of the concerned sport. It is 5000 EUR per team.

- Upon their arrival each Country or region must pay the remaining balance to the OC. The OC can receive this payment in EUR or Renminbi (RMB) at the official rate of exchange.

Any partial or complete withdrawal unannounced by a NUSF to the OC and the Championships Department of FISU or announced less than two weeks prior to the start of the competition and causing extra costs to the OC can be charged at the price of 80 EUR/night/person.





> International Technical Official (ITO) Cost

- The participating delegations shall bear ITO's costs of travel, per diem, board and lodging in proportion to the number of teams registered.

- The total amount of costs shall be divided by the total number of participants and all participating countries shall pay their share in proportion to the number of their participants.

Insurance

Each delegation must have the appropriate insurance to cover all activities (including travel and competition, etc.), as they are not the responsibility of the OC nor FISU.

As the OC is solely responsible for first aid on-site and transfer to the designated hospital. Any other diagnostic treatments or hospitalization shall be covered by the delegation insurance.

Medical assistance

OC provide First Aid at the competition and training venue (ambulances with paramedics). OC has also a contract with two hospitals- distance between the competition venue and the hospital is 2-8 km.

• Anti-doping

The doping control will be provided according to the FISU regulations and standards in partnership with the China Anti-doping Agency (CHINADA). At the competition venue will be a special room dedicated for the anti-doping control. The CHINADA will complete 8 doping tests within 1 day in accordance with the regulations of FISU.

Competition Venue


There are three competition venues and two training venues (three training pitches) for events.

The distance between venues, as well as between venues and hotel, shall not exceed 6.5 kilometers and 18 minutes by car.

Accommodation


Accommodation for all participating athletes and officials will be in Shanghai Fuyue Hotel. OC will arrange accommodation according to the itinerary of the delegation in accordance with the provisions of the FISU General Hanbook.

Shanghai Fuyue Hotel is built according to the standards of high star hotels and is a super large business conference and vacation hotel. The hotel has a total construction area of 105000 square meters and has the largest lobby in Shanghai. It has 1000 sets of various luxury guest rooms.

• Accommodation Booking & Cancellation Policy

If the schedule of the delegation changes, please contact the OC.

- Reservation Process
- Reservations should be made in advance to ensure availability.

- If the arrival time is late/early and the departure time is earlier/later than the official date announced, the hotel's order will not be cancelled. You can check in early or delay the check-in, and the accommodation fee will be charged based on the actual check-in date. But be sure to inform OC or the hotel in advance of the specific check-in time.

- Cancellation Policy
- Booking must be cancelled at least 7 days in advance.
- Delayed cancellation or non check-in may result in:





a) If the reservation is cancelled for more than 7 days, the hotel will not charge a cancellation fee.

b) If the reservation is cancelled within 3-7 days, the hotel will charge 50% of the first day fee for the order.

c) If the reservation is cancelled within 1-3 days, the hotel will charge 80% of the first day fee for the order.

d) If cancelled on the same day, the hotel will charge 100% of the first day fee for the order.

- special circumstances such as injury, visa rejection, flight cancellation delay, etc. (Implement according to the above policies)

Check-In and Check-Out info

- The check-in time is after 2:00 pm every day.

- The check-out time is before 12:00 noon every day.

- The requirements for early check-in or delayed check-out may vary depending on the availability and may incur additional fees.

Payment and Billing

- Late check-out charges a late fee, with 50% of the room fee charged before 6:00 pm on the same day and 100% charged after 6:00 pm.

- Clothing cleaning fees.

- Compensation for damaged facilities and equipment.

- The cost of ordering in room meals.

Occupancy and Guest Policy

 The current maximum occupancy rate for Double room is 2 people, for single room is 1 people.

- Extra charges for single room ascend to 50 euro per pax per night.

- Participation fee is 140 EUR per person and per night for extra officials (Including accommodation, catering, drinking water, and transportation, etc.)

Damages and Liabilities

- Guests are responsible for any damages caused to the room or hotel property during their stay.

- The hotel is not liable for any loss or theft of personal belongings.

Noise and Behavior

- Guests are expected to respect the quiet enjoyment of other guests.

- Excessive noise or disruptive behavior may result in eviction without a refund.

Safety and Security





- Guests should adhere to all safety and security guidelines the hotel provides.

- The hotel is not responsible for any accidents, injuries, or losses that occur on its premises.

• Catering

All participating athletes and officials are scheduled to dine all day at the Shanghai Fuyue Hotel. Also, halal menus are available.

Breakfast

- Breakfast will be served at the respective accommodation. The restaurant opening hours will be adapted to accommodate the event schedule and ensure that athletes and officials will be able to eat before leaving to the competition venue. All hotels offer a buffet-style breakfast with a variety of products.

- Breakfast opening hours: 07:00-10:00

Lunch & Dinner

- Lunch and dinner for all client groups will be served directly at Shanghai Fuyue Hotel. The food will be offered buffet-style, so everyone can choose their own meal. In order to allow all participants to eat their meals, the opening hours will be adjusted to the daily competition programme. Also, different drinks will be available.

- Lunch opening hours: 11:00-14:00

- Dinner opening hours: 18:00-20:00

> Lunch or Dinner Boxes are available when necessary.

- If the delegation is unable to dine at the hotel during opening hours due to the competition. OC will provide Lunch or Dinner Boxes for the delegation at the competition venue. Lunch or Dinner Boxes will be prepared according to the dishes in the hotel buffet.

Official Entry Points

The two official airports are:

• Shanghai Pudong International Airport (IATA code: PVG, ICAO code: ZSPD)

It is located in the Pudong New Area of Shanghai, China. It is approximately 30 kilometers away from the city center, 68 to 70 kilometers away from the hotel (competition venue) where the delegation will stay, and 70 to 90 minutes by car.

• Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (IATA: SHA, ICAO: ZSSS)

It is only 13 kilometers away from the city center, 27 to 30 kilometers away from the hotel (competition venue) where the delegation will stay, and 30 to 50 minutes by car.

Visa Information

• Visa Policy

Except for the visa-free persons as specified, the foreigners who participate in Shanghai 2024 FISU University World Championship Futsal shall apply for the Chinese visa from the embassies or consulates of China in their countries, or any other diplomatic institutes authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China.

• Visa Application and Assistance

The participating teams that need to apply for visa must provide requested personnel information & passport copies and submit them to OC before May 10, 2024.

After receiving relevant information, OC will complete the issuance of invitation letters as soon as possible.

Transportation

Overview

OC will provide efficient, secure, and convenient transportation services for all delegations to participate in all official activities. The services are only available for the accredited delegation members, liaisons, ITOs, FISU Families, other special guests according to FISU regulations and members of OC.

Delegation Transportation Services

The transportation services for delegations will be available between venues, accommodations, and sites of official activities including:

- Pick up on the day of arrival and departure
- To and from competition and training venues
- To and from the site of the Opening Ceremony and Closing Ceremony
- Cultural exchange activities
- Dedicated vehicles for doping tests

Each delegation will be provided with a dedicated bus and 1-2 attachés.

The details of the bus and attachés will be publicized after the registration of the delegation's Quantitative Entries.

Competition and Training

Bus transfer services between accommodations and venues will be arranged for delegations and referees according to the competition and training schedules.

Games Spectating

Each delegation may contact the delegation attachés half a day in advance to book the bus transfer for watching other delegation's games.





• Opening and Closing Ceremonies

For the Opening Ceremony and Closing Ceremony, the shuttle buses, minibuses, and MPVs will be provided for all delegations, guests, technical officials, and referees to and from the site of ceremonies.

• Hotel round-trip to venues

OC will provide buses, business vehicles, and cars for delegations, ITOs, officials from FISU and FUSC to travel between hotels and event venues, in order to ensure the use of vehicles for the event.

- If the delegation has other needs, OC would assist in resolving them.
